Installation Instructions



Real Truck Bed Protection System®

DODGE RAM 2002 – 2008 DOFPAK1

*Requires a Phillips screwdriver and both a T30 & T40 Torx bit (with bolt in tie downs)

NOT INCLUDED

Please read all instructions before beginning the installation process. Install videos available at <u>DualLiner.com/dualliner-videos</u>

While temperature does not affect your DualLiner, it is easier to install when the bedliner is above 50 degrees Fahrenheit. If working in colder temperatures, it is helpful to warm the bedliner indoors prior to installation. The mat may take a "set" while rolled. If possible, unroll the mat and let it "relax" in the sun to make it easier to work with. If installing in cold weather it may take several weeks for the mat to fully relax.

IMPORTANT - Truck Bed Preparation:

- If you have bolted in tie downs, you must remove the tie downs using a T40 Torx Driver.
- If you have welded in tie downs, the sidewalls will fit over them, they do not need to be removed.

Step 1: Install the loadguard panel. (Fig. 1)

• Snap the panel over the top rail and behind the factory tie down locations in the front of the truck.

Step 2: Install the sidewall panels. (Fig. 2)

- Align the top edge of the side wall panel underneath therail.
- *If your truck has rail caps, tuck the ends of the side wall behind the rail caps.
- Connect the side wall to the loadguard using the provided pine tree pins.
- *Use a Phillips head screwdriver as an alignment tool if needed. If you have rail caps you may not need to use the pine tree pins as the rail cap and rubber floor will interlock the system.
- Reattach bolted tie downs using a Phillips head to align the holes.
- *Insert the tie down screws, leaving them loose until all 4 are started, then tighten.
- Repeat on the other side.

Step 3: Install the ZeroSkid Rubber Floor®. (Fig. 3)

- Lift the mat into the truck and unroll with nub side down.
- Start tucking the mat into the channel from front to back.
- * Tip: It is generally easiest to tuck one side, then the other side.
- Make sure it is pulled as far forward as possible for best fit.
- Thematwill "settle" into position, sometimes giving it a kick or shuffling your feet will help it find its place.

Step 4: Install the tailgate panel. (Fig. 4)

- Remove 8 of the 10 access latch panel screws using a T30 Torx Driver. Leave the top 2 center latch screws in place. The tailgate panel will overlap the tailgate capa bit for the holes to line up properly for installation.
- Place a nylon spacer on each screw and reinstall.
- *Optional: Drill1/4" holes in the center of each slot of the panel. Lift up the panel and clear any drill chips away. Insert one pin in each hole. Do not over-tighten, and do not use power tools. We have also included double-sided tape, should you choose not to drill. (See insert)
