# **Installation Instructions**



Real Truck Bed Protection System®

### Ford Superduty 8' Bed 2011-2016 F-250/F-350/F-450 FOS11PAK

\*Requires a Torx T30 bit and a 10mm wrench
NOT INCLUDED

# Please read all instructions before beginning the installation process. Install videos available at <u>DualLiner.com/dualliner-videos</u>

While temperature does not affect your DualLiner, it is easier to install when the bedliner is above 50 degrees Fahrenheit. If working in colder temperatures, it is helpful to warm the bedliner indoors prior to installation. The mat may take a "set" while rolled. If possible, unroll the mat and let it "relax" in the sun to make it easier to work with. If installing in cold weather it may take several weeks for the mat to fully relax.

#### **IMPORTANT - Truck Bed Preparation:**

Remove the 4 bed tie downs and bed extender using a 10mm wrench (if applicable).
 Reserve the hardware for reinstallation.

#### **Step 1: Install the loadguard panel.** (*Fig. 1*)

- Snap the panel over the top rail at the front of the truck.
- \*Tip: Place your hand behind the panel and flex the sides in.

#### Step 2: Install the sidewall panels. (Fig. 2)

- The side walls are in 2 pieces. Tuck the front (short) section under the bed rail first.
- Snap in place, then continue to the back (longer) section.
- If your truck has bedrail caps, tuck the ends of the sidewall behind the rail cap.
- Reinstall the tie downs leaving them loose until both are installed. As you tighten, lift the panel upward and tighten completely.
- If your truck is equipped with a bed extender, you will see three pin marks at the back edge of the side panel that aligns with the holes for your bed extender. Open these up to the correct size with a drill bit and reinstall your bed extender.

#### **Step 3: Install the ZeroSkid Rubber Floor®.** (*Fig. 3*)

- Lift the mat into the truck and unroll with nub side down.
- Start tucking the mat into the channel from front to back.
- \* Tip: It is generally easiest to tuck one side, then the other side.
- Make sure it is pulled as far forward as possible for bestfit.
- The mat will "settle" into position, sometimes giving it a kick or shuffling your feet will help it find its place.

#### **Step 4: Install the tailgate panel.** (*Fig. 4*)

If your truck is equipped with the optional tailgate step, you will not use the tailgate panel.

- Remove 6 out of the 8 tailgate screws using a T30 Torx Driver, leaving the lower middle ones in place.
- Align the panel using the predrilled holes.
- Attach a spacer and a screw and reinstall the screws to the panel with a hand tool to prevent stripping.
